Dr. Godley also was a Professor of Ophthalmology at MD Anderson Cancer Center and established its retina service.

Dr. Godley is credited with the rapid turn-around of the Ophthalmology and Visual Sciences (OVS) Department at UTMB - significantly improving patient satisfaction, operational efficiency, and growth in faculty and services.

Dr. Godley earned a bachelor's degree in biology magna cum laude at Brown University and completed the combined MD and PhD program at Harvard Medical School and MIT. After completing a medical internship at the Brigham and Women's Hospital, he did an ophthalmology residency at the University of Iowa, followed by retina fellowship at Moorfield's Eye Hospital and the University of London, and the Retina Institute of Maryland. Dr. Godley completed the requirements for an MBA at Northwestern University's Kellogg School of Management where he focused on leadership and finance. He is a fellow of the American Academy of Ophthalmology and the American College of Surgeons.
